



As announced previously, there was a fire accident (17.6.2020) on the roof of the building where Kaivogen operates. Luckily all our operations are located on the second floor or lower and according to the latest investigations these facilities are not impacted. Due to mapping of areas impacted and other investigations we have been forced to operate with limited resources. We have been working at temporary offices and remotely to ensure that our customers will receive orders in time. Fortunately, according to the latest news from our landlord, there is a chance to gain access to our facilities by early August. Since July is traditionally summer vacation time in Finland, this temporary pause of production does not significantly change our production schedule designed before the accident. If unexpectedly the building remains closed for a longer time, we already have a plan to move our production and laboratory to temporary facilities.
